Let everyone be quick to hear [be a careful, thoughtful listener], slow to speak [a speaker of carefully chosen words and], slow to anger [patient, reflective, forgiving]; for the [resentful, deep-seated] anger of man does not produce the righteousness of God [that standard of behavior which He requires from us]."

James 1:19-20 AMP

As I grow older and move further along in my journey as a father, husband, and follower of Christ, the more vital this verse seems. As a child, the meaning behind these words appeared elementary. "Listen to what others say and think about what you say," (or maybe that was just my interpretation). It has evolved and deepened into so much more, however, as I've watched the damage words can do to others.

As I've experienced how careless, irresponsible words have affected me, I also recount wonderful examples of people who were almost methodical about each syllable and its effect on the recipient. I felt safe talking to them. To me, the difference is their intentional and active listening skills and how they related within the conversation. They truly listened with the filter of not just hearing and responding, but of understanding and internalizing what was said in order to respond in a meaningful and intentional way.

Words have always been powerful and their impact immense, but over the past couple of years the careless way they are thrown around and the irresponsible manner in which words are used, as well as the intentional divisiveness in which some yield them, have been even more exposed. So those affected by this misuse of communication, and the news is full of those from all walks of life, are hurting as a result. Knowing and experiencing this leads to the last part being very hard. It has grown increasingly difficult to assume positive intent with other people when our experience is that of pain and manipulation.
